2 Chronicles 29-31

Prepare your heart and mind for worship on Sunday, August 14, 2022, each day this week, with the following passages and questions. (RTYB'22= Read Through Your Bible in 2022)

Monday, August 8 **2 Chronicles 29:1-19**

-What was done to restore the temple for worship?

-RTYB'22 – Hosea 10-12; and pray for the Zambo family today.

Tuesday, August 9 **2 Chronicles 29:20-36**

-What were the main components of the worship that took place after the temple was ready?

-RTYB'22 – Hosea 13,14; Micah 1; and pray for the Yoda family today.

Wednesday, August 10 **2 Chronicles 30:1-12**

-How did Hezekiah appeal to all the tribes to be involved in the Passover? What responses did He receive?

-RTYB'22 – Micah 2-4; and pray for the Amaswache family today.

Thursday, August 11 **Exodus 11:1-12:13**

-The original Passover was very significant. The blood of the Passover lamb was a picture of the blood of the Lamb of God who later would take away the sins of the world.

-RTYB'22 – Micah 5-7; and pray for the Noyes family today.

Friday, August 12 **2 Chronicles 30:13-27**

-What made this celebration of the Passover unique?

-RTYB'22 – Nahum 1-3; and pray for the Rajan family today.

Saturday, August 13 **2 Chronicles 31:1-2**

-One of the idols Hezekiah destroyed is explained in 2 Kings 18:1-6 and Numbers 21:4-9.

-How can an object with a good origin become an idol?

-RTYB'22 – 2 Chronicles 33-34; Zeph 1; pray for P.K. Moses family today.

-How did the people respond to the command to give to the Lord's work?
